ABOUT THE INSTITUTION

Established in 15th May, 1969, Sangola Taluka Shetkari Shikshan Prasarak Mandal, Sangola aims at providing the quality education to socially and economically backward and weaker sections of society for the overall development and progression of deprived region of Sangola Tahsil. Since its establishment, the institution has been running a unit called New English School and Junior College Sangola which includes technical department and professional courses. In order to cater higher educational demands of society, the institute came forward with science college called Vidnyan Mahavidyalaya on 23rd September, 1991. Besides science stream, other programs like Bachelor of Arts (B.A.), Entire Computer Science (E.C.S.), Bachelor of Computer Application (B.C.A.) are introduced in the college. The institute has started post graduate programs like M.A. English, M.A. History, M.Sc. Computer Science has started in June 2004 and June 2009 respectively.

Since its establishment, the college has been doing tremendous progress in educational field and has become important academic and research centre in the region of Sangola Taluka. In its third cycle the college has been reaccredited with grade "B" in 2018. The college has been contributing to intellectual and academic development of students through the various departments under Arts and Science facilities. The college takes utmost care of academic progress of students. The is not only providing quality education but motivating and encouraging students to participate in cultural activities and sports. It has large playground and is connected to both railway and bus stand.

Vision of the Institution

To provide higher quality education to the students from socio-economically backward and poor family, and friendly atmosphere for teaching, learning and research process. To shape the students in becoming globally competent, skilled and socially oriented human power.

Aims and Objectives of the Institution

1. To open the schools & colleges in order to give primary, secondary, higher secondary, vocational, technical education and also higher and professional education to the students, especially from the rural area.
2. To open the Montessaries, Laboratories, Technical training centers, Libraries and hostels for boys and girls, in order to help them to complete education, upbringing them in the main stream of society and to create an interest and awareness about education.
3. To provide them scholarship & other facilities in order to develop all round personality of students and to develop their mental, physical health and economic status. To create a sense of patriotism, social responsibility and environment among students.
4. To give the guidance & information to students and people from rural area by the experts from academic, social, political, cultural, agriculture and economic fields.
5. To create volunteers and social workers and to train them in order to develop the rural area in all fields.
6. This institution does not believe in any caste, religion and discrimination. All students from any caste are admitted in the college, especially students from reserve category are admitted with priority.
7. This is non-political institution.

IMPORTANT INSTRUCTIONS FOR STUDENTS REGARDING ADMISSION AND ON EXAMINATION :-

- 1) If backward students / parents have any problems, they have to inform it to the Principal or SC/ST Cell of the college.
- 2) Documents (marksheet, L.C., T.C., etc) that are submitted in office for conforming regular admission, will not be returned back or zerox copies of these documents will not be given.
- 3) While taking admission fill online application form.



- 4) If any student has applied or wants to apply to other Courses, e. g. Agriculture, I. T. I., Diplomas, Engineering, Medical etc. (which are not available in this college), such student must inform about this in written form to the Principal, before or after taking the admission.
- 5) If any student wants to leave the college, he / she has to inform it to the office in written form and has to pay the fees according to rules.
- 6) The list of those students, whose admission are rejected, will be displayed on the notice board. The Principal reserves the right of rejecting the admission.
- 7) Those students, who are exist on the roll-call sheet of the college at the preceding year and want to admit this year for the course of next year, must apply newly once again.
- 8) Those students, who come from the area of P.A.H. Solapur University, have to get Transference Certificate (T.C.) from their previous college. For this, after taking admission, they have to send an application to the previous college through the channel of this college. Also they have to attach the receipt of the fee along with this application, paid in the previous college for getting their T.C.
- 9) a] Students from the colleges, affiliated to other universities except of Solapur University, have to give T.C. and also have to get Migration Certificate from their previous university. It is necessary to submit this Migration certificate to Solapur University and get Eligibility Certificate from Solapur University.
b] For this, they have to pay migration fee to the previous University. They have to send an application for migration certificate to the previous University through the channel of the Principal of the previous college. Besides this, they have to pay the fee in the previous college for getting T.C.
c] After taking admission in this college, they have to apply to Solapur university for getting Eligibility Certificate. Permission from University, the admission in this college will be confirmed.



d] An application, for Eligibility certificate, will have to send to University through the channel of this college.

- 10) Students have to attach the following documents with the application,
i) Certificate showing the passing of previous examination, ii) Mark-sheets iii) Transference Certificate (T.C.) iv) Character Certificate.
- 11) While getting admission in any class, students have to submit two attested copies of mark-sheets in the office. Beside this, students taking admission in B.A Part I and B.Sc.Part I have to submit original mark-sheet in the office. They should keep xeroxed copies of these certificates with them.
- 12) Students coming from economic backward category (EBC), students from backward category (SC,ST,NT,SBC etc), sons & daughters of freedom-soldiers, sons & daughters of primary teachers, sons & daughters of soldiers in military- these students get concession in the fees. For getting such concessions, they should apply in the prescribed form & within the period with necessary documents. Model applications are available in the office. It will be the responsibility of students to submit such application in the office before the concerned date. If the application for the above concession is rejected / denied by government, students will have to pay all concerned fees.
- 13) **All the Students of first year under graduate & post graduate should fill-up to form of Sem-I to generate PRN of terms they will not be allowed for further examination**

TO CANCEL THE ADMISSION: -

1. If student wants to cancel the admission he/she or parents have to inform it in written application.
2. If the admission is cancelled , students have to pay the complete fee of the first term.
3. If student wants to cancel the admission in the second term, he/she has to inform it in written application before eight days after starting second term, otherwise he/she has to pay the complete fee of the second term.

SPECIAL INSTRUCTIONS: -

The information and instructions regarding examinations, dates of filling up form of university examinations, various scholarships, certificates, concessions, various competitions



and information about sports dept, library, N.S.S., N.C.C., etc. will be displayed on the notice board of the college. It is the responsibility of students to see these information and instructions on the notice board. If any student does not see these information on the notice board, then the college will not be responsible for its loss.

RULES AND INSTRUCTIONS FOR STUDENTS TO KEEP DISCIPLINE:

1. According to the Circular Class Representative (C.R.) will be selected on the merit and University Representative (U.R) will be selected through voting.
2. Gymkhana Day and Certificate Distribution function will be organized in the college and also there may be the change in it according to the situation. Students have to pay the fee of it in the office.
3. After taking admission in the college, each student has to submit two photos of size 2" X 2" (taken from front side) in the library before eight days. Identity-card will be given to students. Students must keep this identity- card with them in the classroom, in the college campus, on the ground, in the library, in the office and in any function of the college, etc. Students must show the identity-card to professors, clerks and other authorities in the college, if demanded. If any student would fail or refuse to show it, this will considered as bad behavior and proper action will be taken on such students.
4. If identity-card is lost, then such student must inform about this in writing. If identity-card is not found before eight days, then new identity-card will be given by charging the fee Rs. 25.
5. Students must come in time and regularly to the college. They must do the study, homework, etc. regularly and continuously. Only taking admission doesn't mean approval of the term. All students must be present regularly in the college and the attendance must be 80% which is compulsory. If this attendance is not as per rule then the Principal has the right to cancel the examination form of such students.
6. When the clases are going on, students must not wander in the porch near by the classroom or must not behave in such a way as to disturb the classes.



7. Each student must take care of the property of the college. Doing the walls dirty, doing harm to the doors and windows, to the benches and tables, and doing harm to the plants and trees in the campus, etc. will be treated as bad and improper behaviour.
8. Students must not behave in such a way as it would harm to the college work, discipline and its prestige, either in the college campus or outside of it. If this is done, severe punishment will be given to such students.
9. Without the permission of the Principal, nobody is allowed to display any board or to perform any function in the college.
10. Selected subjects should be according to the rules of the University and as given in the prospectus. If this is not so, then students must change their subjects and take other subjects according to the rules.
11. Every student must see the instructions on the notice board every day. Instructions are not sent to the classroom. If any student would fail to see it on the notice board, then the college will not be responsible for its loss.
12. According to the University rules, each student must keep University receipt and identity-card with him/her in the examination hall, while university examinations are going on. Students must show their receipt and identity card to the junior or senior supervisor; if demanded. Those students, who would fail to show it, are not allowed to appear for examinations.
13. Persons, who have not taken admission in the college, are not allowed to enter in the college campus without the permission of the Principal.
14. It is necessary for all students to sit in the classroom for all periods.
15. Students should not wander near by the ladies' room.
16. Students who have not their regular lectures/classes, are advised to sit in the library or in the reading-room during the time.
17. If students have any problems/complaints, they should inform their complaints in writing to the Principal.
18. When students are going in the classes, they not call to other students sitting in the classes. For this they might take the help of the peon.



19. Students of B.Sc. Part- I,II and III will have to fill up the breakage according to the rules.
20. Students, remaining absent in practicals and examinations, are fined, according to the rules of the college. All students must complete their experiment notebook, journal, regularly, otherwise they are not allowed to enter in the laboratory.
21. Books from the library are given and accepted only on the prescribed days. If books are returned late the fine will be charged for each day.
22. Books must be treated and read with proper care. If book has any damage already, then it should be informed to the librarian in writing and should get another copy of it.
23. If major damage is done to the book, then the complete price of the book must be paid and if it is lost, then one and half percent price of it should be paid.
24. If damage is done to the property of college by any student, then in such case, compensation will be taken from such student.
25. Students must behave modestly with the Principal, professors, non-teaching staff and with peons, etc.
26. Any information or news about the college and institution must not be published in the newspaper or else where, without the permission of the Principal.
27. Any instruction or paper must not be displayed on the notice board without the permission of the Principal.
28. The decision of giving admission to the student for the next year, by taking into consideration the previous behavior, depend on the Principal.
29. If someone wants to complain about discipline -breaking or other bad treatment, he/she has to complain it in writing to the Vice-Principal or to the Chairman of the discipline-committee of the college.
30. If someone is observed doing copy or other illegal behavior at the time of University as well as examinations, such students might be punished under the Indian penal code column 7.
31. **Students beyond the admission capacity of 360 in B.A. I, will be admitted in the 4th division which is Non-grantable. So the students admitted in this non-grant division will have to pay paying fees of Rs. 1500/- in addition to regular admission fees.**



32. Students taking admission to departmental short - term courses, should pay the additional fee at the admission.
33. It is the whole right of the principal to change the above rules or to take decision about.
34. There is the facility of students Health Center in the college.
35. Students have to fill up anti-ragging undertaking form online on the website www.amanmovement.org.
36. All the students those are taking admission in first, second & This year of granted of non granted courses are compulsory to fill up anti Raging undertaking form online at www.amanmovement.org
37. Physically handicapped students are instructed to submit their certificates to get fee concession upto Rs.5000/-
38. Gymkhana Department -----
 - i) The facility of national and international sports.
 - ii) National and state level players get in fees concession.
 - iii) The selected candidates in University team will get track suit and D.A.

Note : • Students must give/appear for College assessment and have to pass result in it.
